No unexpected maintenance costs are projected at this time, with maintenance expenses expected to remain steady. The fuel truck purchase was successfully negotiated, yielding a \$5,000 surplus that will be allocated as a contingency for any unforeseen maintenance needs. Additionally, an increase in fuel sales this year has helped offset other operational expenses at the airport.

# A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ASSIGNMENT OF LEASE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Rutherford Airport Authority ("Airport Authority") entered into a Lease Agreement with G. Donald Greene, dated April 19, 2002, for a term commencing March 15, 2002, and continuing for a period of twenty-five (25) years, for the premises then known as Hangar K, Unit 1; and

WHEREAS, the Airport Authority subsequently entered into a modified and revised Lease Agreement with G. Donald Greene, dated June 15, 2010, which extended the term to a total of forty (40) years, and for the same premises but revised to reflect as **Hangar 3E**; and

WHEREAS, Hangar 3E was the subject of Assignment of Lease Agreement dated August 11, 2010, recorded in Deed Book 1019 at Page 543, Rutherford County Registry, to Mickey B. Cochran; and

WHEREAS, Hangar 3E was the subject of Assignment of Lease Agreement dated August 16, 2013, recorded in Deed Book 1069 at Page 9, Rutherford County Registry, to J. Michael Lynch; and

WHEREAS, Hangar 3E was the subject of Assignment of Lease Agreement dated February 28, 2020, recorded in Book 2031 at Page 1089, Rutherford County Registry, to Steve M. Scala; and

WHEREAS, Hangar 3E was the subject of Assignment of Lease Agreement dated December 29, 2022, recorded in Book 2069 at Page 398, Rutherford County Registry, to Gerald L. Stimple; and

WHEREAS, Section 12 of both the original and subsequent Lease Agreements for Hangar 3E allows Lessee therein to assign the full rights under the said Lease Agreement only upon the written consent of the Airport Authority, and states that such consent shall not be unreasonably withheld, as well as provide for right of first refusal by the Airport Authority to purchase any improvements and buildings built thereon; and

WHEREAS, Gerald L. Stimple now wishes to assign his full rights under the Lease Agreement for Hangar 3E to Russell M. Hyde for the consideration Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rutherford Airport Authority, that:

The Airport Authority consents and authorizes Gerald L. Stimple to assign his rights under the Lease Agreement for Hangar 3E to Russell M. Hyde contingent upon the execution of a duly binding Assignment of Lease Agreement for Hangar 3E in the general form attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

The Airport Authority chooses not to exercise its right of first refusal to purchase improvements and buildings constructed on the premises of Hangar 3E set forth in the Lease Agreements referenced herein. The waiver of such right of first refusal is effective only as to the specific transaction referenced above and any and all such rights in any Lease Agreement referenced herein are specifically reserved as to all other transactions and parties.

# A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ASSIGNMENT OF LEASE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Rutherford Airport Authority ("Airport Authority") entered into a Lease Agreement with Tom Bellino a/k/a Thomas C Bellino, Jr., dated September 14, 2005, for a term commencing September 14, 2005, and continuing until February 1, 2030, for the premises shown as **Hangar 4G**; and

WHEREAS, the Airport Authority subsequently entered into a new Lease Agreement with Tom Bellino a/k/a Thomas C. Bellino, Jr., dated August 8, 2006, which extended the term to a total of forty (40) years commencing September 14, 2005, and for the same premises, **Hangar 4G**; and

WHEREAS, Hangar 4G was the subject of Assignment of Lease Agreement dated February 1, 2009, recorded in Deed Book 1002 at Page 143, Rutherford County Registry, to Triple Vistas, LLC; and

WHEREAS, Hangar 4G was the subject of Assignment of Lease Agreement dated March 16, 2015, recorded in Deed Book 1101 at Page 587, Rutherford County Registry, to Gerald L. Stimple; and

WHEREAS, Section 12 of both the original and subsequent Lease Agreements for Hangar 4G allows Lessee therein to assign the full rights under the said Lease Agreement only upon the written consent of the Airport Authority, and states that such consent shall not be unreasonably withheld, as well as provide for right of first refusal by the Airport Authority to purchase any improvements and buildings built thereon; and

WHEREAS, Gerald L. Stimple now wishes to assign his full rights under the Lease Agreement for Hangar 4G to Laura J. Frese for the consideration Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rutherford Airport Authority, that:

The Airport Authority consents and authorizes Gerald L. Stimple to assign his rights under the Lease Agreement for Hangar 4G to Laura J. Frese contingent upon the execution of a duly binding Assignment of Lease Agreement for Hangar 4G in the general form attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

The Airport Authority chooses not to exercise its right of first refusal to purchase improvements and buildings constructed on the premises of Hangar 4G set forth in the Lease Agreements referenced herein. The waiver of such right of first refusal is effective only as to the specific transaction referenced above and any and all such rights in any Lease Agreement referenced herein are specifically reserved as to all other transactions and parties.
