

Reduced Pricing Policy

Goal:

Animal control staff is seeking to extend the current “Reduce Day” to a full “Reduced Pricing” policy to our current pricing policy.

Purpose:

Reduced Pricing will be used to help reduce the number of animals at the county animal control facility due to being overcrowded or when receiving a large influx of animals due to cases beyond our control and will help reduce the number of animals being euthanized. During any period of Reduced Pricing, citizens shall be required to pay the cost of rabies vaccinations on animals eligible for reduced price.

Policy:

Reduced Pricing will only be used when both the county manager and the animal control director deem it necessary.

- Both the animal control director and county manager have to approve Reduced Pricing to be used, which will be for a specific period of time not to exceed 45 days in succession.
- The county manager and the animal control director will determine that the amount of the reduced fee and that reducing fee for the determined time period is a reasonable strategy to correct issues facing animal control necessitated by reason of the number and/or length of stay of the type of animals being reduced.
- Each citizen shall be required to pay the cost necessary to cover rabies vaccinations for eligible animals during any Reduced Pricing.
- Reduced Pricing must be posted on the animal control facility Facebook page throughout any time period Reduced Pricing is enacted.
