

Adding Reduced Day to Current Pricing Structure

Goal:

Animal control staff is seeking to add a “Reduce Day” to our current pricing policy.

Purpose:

The Reduce Day will be used to help reduce the number of animals at the county animal control facility due to being overcrowded, to reduce the large influx of animals due to cases beyond our control and this will help reduce the number of animals being euthanized. On Reduce Day, citizens shall only be required to pay the cost of rabies vaccinations on animals eligible for reduced price on Reduce Day.

Policy:

The Reduce Day will only be used when the County Manager and the Animal Control Director deem it necessary.

- Both the Animal Control Director and County Manager must approve for Reduce Day to be used.
- The facility must be within ten (10) animals of the maximum number of animals permitted at the animal control facility for the type of animals being reduced.
- Animals eligible for reduction on Reduce Day shall have been housed at the animal control facility for a minimum of 30 days. Animals housed fewer than 30 days shall not be eligible for reduction in price on Reduce Day.
- Each citizen shall be required to pay the cost necessary to cover rabies vaccinations for eligible animals on Reduce Day.
- Each Reduce Day must be posted on the animal control facility Facebook page a minimum of 5 working days before day selected for Reduce Day.
