## Steve,

- 1. Heliservice would like to request permission to bury a 500 gallon propane tank near the yellow X in the picture below. I looked around there hangar today and this seems to be the most effective place to put this tank. The propane tank must be at least ten feet from the building and ten feet away from any outside electrical component. They would most likely use North State Gas to install the tank and the gas lines would need to be inspected before completion. The hole for the tank would be 4ft. wide, 12ft. long and 5ft. deep. The spot selected for the tank will be out of the way and still close to the building.
- 2. Heliservice would also like to request permission to place an 8ft. x 30ft. concrete pad behind the hangar where they can set the a/c compressor / shop air compressor. This pad would replace several small existing pads and allow them to have a small break area with a picnic table out of the mud & rotor wash.

Heliservice's on-site employee "Chris" is working hard to get the hangar ready for the staff and equipment... If the Airport Authority can approve these two request before the next board meeting it would be very helpful. Let me know if you have any questions or concerns. Thanks
