Public Hearing - Building Reuse Project

Summary:

A public hearing will be held to discuss a building reuse project for Cardinal Tissue and approve using an existing economic grant to provide one-half of the required local match.

In January 2018, the County approved an economic development grant to provide a grant equal to 50 percent of new property taxes paid over a 5 or 10-year time period. The anticipated grant amount approved in January exceeds the required local match for the building reuse project. Rutherford County's portion will not exceed \$12,500. A resolution authorizing the use of the existing local industrial incentive grant as a portion of the qualifying 5% local cash match required within the scope of the building reuse and restoration program application and authorizing the County Manager to submit a building reuse and restoration grant application in support of Cardinal Tissue, LLD is provided for the Board's consideration.

Also for the Board's consideration will be a resolution that would authorize the use of existing repaid Golden Leaf grant funds for an equipment lease option
