



When 73-year-old Joe Frady began experiencing sudden chest pain, he trusted his instincts and drove himself to Rutherford Regional Health System's Emergency **Department**. Within moments, our care team recognized a STEMI heart attack and activated the Cardiac Catheterization Lab, where Dr. Hearon and team quickly opened a 95% coronary blockage and placed a stent, saving Joe's life.

Following his procedure, Joe was closely monitored in the Intensive Care Unit, then transitioned to our Cardiac Rehabilitation Program, where he completed 12 weeks of guided recovery. He now continues his follow-up care in our Outpatient Cardiology Clinic with Tara England, **NP**, feeling strong and grateful.

Joe calls our team "a NASCAR crew" — moving with speed, precision, and compassion. He says, "I can't imagine going to any other hospital."


